It's Official!

The MD C crest design is now finalized and available for pre-order. The vest crest is 10 inches (@ \$20), the jacket crest is 4 inches (@ \$5).

Production is underway, with delivery expected in March. Shipping and handling charges will be at a minimum and up to the club as to which way they want them shipped, parcel post, 3-day post, UPS or FedEx. Or shipping is free, if you talk one of your club members to drive to NW Calgary and pick up the crests at CST Tim Haight's house.

"The MD C Office is taking orders now and we are also taking payment now. As per our previous policy, no crests will be shipped with out payment in full. We also accept MasterCard and VISA!"

MD C pins are almost ready for production and should be available at the MD C Convention in St Albert in May.



Leadership? Service? It's what Lions do!


