
I look forward to seeing you at the Convention and would remind you of the upcoming Regional Lions Leadership Institute, as well as Diabetes awareness day.

#### **Pictures and Submissions**

We are more than pleased to promote your events and activities in the Lions Roar - we want to showcase what you are doing.

Here are some suggestions:

- The best pictures show people doing things; the worst pictures show people standing around at presentation of awards and donations, although we will use them when they are significant.
- Modern cameras and cell phones are capable of taking excellent pictures - focus is rarely a problem, but camera motion is, particularly with indoor and low light images. The worst stance is the familiar one where the camera is held at arms length, or with elbows extend-

ed - it is very difficult to hold the camera still. Consider placing the camera on a solid surface, or resting at least one arm on or against a solid surface. Note or against a solid surface. Note  $\frac{1}{2}$  that when everything in a picture is out of focus or blurry, it is o era motion. Also, more light is always better - it makes for faster shutter speeds.

- Learn to analyze what you see in the preview - compose the image, and be patient.
- Pictures should always be accompanied with the names of the people in the image, and ≥ context - a description of what  $\stackrel{\circ}{\pm}$ is happening where and when and why.
- Small images with file sizes under

200k reproduce poorly and cannot be adjusted very well. Anything above 400k will be fine. Note that when you "email" a picture, it generally is reduced in size to make it easier to send, but prints poorly. Instead, attach the original to your email.

Written submissions can be in almost any format, but do not embed pictures in Word documents - send them separately - it is easier to format items that way.

When submitting PDFs, try to use space effectively - extraneous white space is hard to get rid of. If PDFs are a challenge, just submit a Word document (images and clipart separately), and I will put it together for you.
