**EDMONTON HERITAGE DAYS FESTIVAL – August 2, 3, 4, 2014**

The Lions will be participating in the Heritage Festival which is held at Hawrelak Park again this year. The positions fill up fast, so if you are interested in volunteering, please see the shift times below and email or call me as soon as possible, with your preferred shift times.

The Heritage Festival has issues every year with volunteers who are unable to carry out the required duties. Volunteers must be able to stand in a ticket booth for 3 or 4 hours, make monetary change quickly and accurately, and be comfortable in a fast-paced environment of serving the (hungry) public.

There are a small number of shifts available in the Count Room and these positions must be filled only with volunteers who are able to quickly and accurately reconcile cash and tickets.

It is imperative that everyone who volunteers, is capable of carrying out the duties as assigned in order for your club to be paid for your services.

Volunteers must be at least 16 years old, so please gather your teenage children and their friends and have them volunteer for ticket sales, provided they are physically capable of standing for extended periods of time, are good at giving change and accurately dispensing meal tickets to the public.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:**

There are 30 to 40 scholarships available to University students, ranging from \$250 to \$400. Each student must register for the chance to win and must work a minimum of 10 hours (2 shifts) to qualify for one ballot. If a student works a shift on each of the 3 days of the festival (3 shifts) they will earn two ballots.

**High School Students:**

Wendy Carter, Volunteer Coordinator, has announced an incentive for high school students to volunteer by crediting a student who works 3 shifts, (one on each of the 3 days) with 20 community volunteer hours. A student who works one shift will be credited with 5 hours, all towards their hours required to graduate. The student must bring a “community hours” letter from their school, and have it signed off by Wendy Carter.

## 27th Annual Lions International Peace Poster Contest

# Peace, Love and Understanding



*Sponsor a Lions International Peace Poster Contest and join clubs worldwide in sharing children's visions of peace with your community.*

### How the Contest Works

Only a Lions club can sponsor the contest in a local school or organized youth group. The contest is open to students 11-13 on November 15, 2014. Participating students are asked to create posters visually depicting the contest theme, "Peace, Love and Understanding."

One winner for each contest sponsored by a club is chosen to advance to the district governor for judging. On the district level, one winner is selected to go on to the multiple district competition and from there one winner is forwarded to International Headquarters for the final judging. Entries are judged at all levels on originality, artistic merit and portrayal of theme.

During the final judging, 23 merit award winners and one grand prize winner are chosen to represent the many entries submitted from around the world.

### Awards

Artists of posters advancing to the final international judging are recognized as follows:

- **International Grand Prize Winner** receives a trip to an award ceremony where he/she will receive a cash award of US\$5,000 (or local equivalent) and an engraved plaque. Two family members (one being the winner's parent or legal guardian) and the sponsoring Lions club president or a club member (as designated by the club president) will accompany the winner to the award ceremony.
- **23 Merit Award Winners** each receive a cash award of US\$500 (or local equivalent) and a certificate of achievement.
